FILETYPES



INDD is a file extension for a page layout file used by Adobe InDesign, can also be opened using Adobe InCopy. INDD stands for INDesign Document. Contains formatting, content, styles, and linked files. Used for Desktop Publishing to create books, magazines, newspapers, flyers, etc.



IDML is an XML representation of an InDesign document or components. This document describes the structure of IDML files, the XML schema for IDML validation, and provides examples of IDML file content.

How to backwards save InDesign files and open them in previous versions



1. Open the .idml file included in itms folder. (Note: .idml files are compatible with InDesign CS4 and later.)
2. Save as .indd with your version of inDesign. Now you are ready to edit this template.
